1. DEAFinitely Darts is a national campaign being run by SignHealth, the healthcare charity for deaf people. We are aiming to create the world record for the largest number of people playing darts at the same time on 21 October. Through this event, we aim to increase awareness around deaf health and raise funds to support our work in this area. The event is being supported by the PDC [Professional Darts Corporation] who have chosen SignHealth as their charity partner.

3. SignHealth is the only UK charity focussed on improving the mental and physical health of deaf people. SignHealth has a track record of delivering change in care and treatment and in providing supported living, advocacy, outreach, psychological therapy and health promotion, all within a BSL supported environment. Projects are located in London, Manchester, Leeds and Birmingham. SignHealth also works with service providers to improve health services for deaf people and with other health and deaf charities to provide health information and education. A grant from the Big Lottery, has enabled SignHealth, in partnership with deaf organisations across the UK, to launch the largest survey of the health of deaf people in the UK later this year.
